

PSR PROJECT: PATRON SAINT BIOGRAPHY

From many of the resources in our library or from the Internet, you are to find a Catholic saint for your project. The saint you choose might be the same one you use for Confirmation, and doing it this year will fulfill that part of your Confirmation requirement. Below are the requirements for this paper. THIS IS YOUR MID-TERM TEST AND IS WORTH 100 POINTS, SO PAY ATTENTION TO DETAILS AND TURN IN A GREAT PROJECT.

- 1. The paper is to be typed or handwritten.**
- 2. This paper must be a minimum of 3 paragraphs, and each paragraph must be at least 4-6 sentences.**

Paragraph I: What is the saint's full name? Where was the saint born? Is there anything special or particularly interesting about this saint's early childhood? This saint is the patron saint of _____.

Paragraph II: Why did you choose this saint? What is it about this saint's life that interested you? What did this person do to obtain sainthood?

Paragraph III: Summary: If you could do one thing like this saint did during his/her lifetime, what would it be? Why? Is this something worth asking God for? Do you think this might be the saint whose name you choose for your Confirmation name? Would you like to form a special relationship with this saint?
